2. Wall Line	The equine is focused, forward, & rhythmic, traveling in a straight line. The line should be 3-6 strides.	10		
3. Short Edge	The equine is focused, forward, & rhythmic, traveling in a straight line with balanced bend in the corners.	10		
4. Diagonal	The equine is focused, forward, & rhythmic, traveling in a straight line with balanced bend in the corners.	10		
5. Short Edge	The equine is focused, forward, & rhythmic, traveling in a straight line with balanced bend in the corners.	10		
6. Wall Line	The equine is focused, forward, & rhythmic, traveling in a straight line. The line should be 3-6 strides.	10
