4.	Wide Rollback	The equine is focused, forward, & utilizes the hind end during a balanced arc. The rollback should be 240–280°	10		
5.	Wall Line	The equine is focused, forward, & rhythmic, traveling in a straight line. The line should be 3–6 strides.	10
