Objective: To demonstrate a canter behavior on the reverse roundpen.

Equipment: Liberty Handling

Arena: Any size that allows the pattern to be executed fully

| Behavior | Description | Points | Score | Remarks |
|---|--|--------|-------|---------|
| 1. Calm Default | The equine remains still and calm, with head forward or turned away from the competitor, as the competitor moves to stand on the left, right, and front, providing a C&T at each position. | 10 | | |
| 2. Canter Right | The equine canters on the right lead for a full circle around the reverse roundpen to the right. | 10 | | |
| 3. Reverse Directions | The equine turns to change direction. | 10 | | |
| 4. Canter Left | The equine canters on the left lead for a full circle around the reverse roundpen to the left. | 10 | | |
| 5. Back | The equine backs two steps away from the handler. | 10 | | |
